- Introduction -

The Advanced Themes Configurator from Vinum Master will allow you to edit your own theme from the default Prestashop > 1.6 theme's,

It is very intuitive and very easy to use.

However some points necessities clarification.

- Install -

The module installs as all Prestashop modules.

But to work, it disables the free ThemeConfigurator module you no longer need.

The installation directory is :

modules/vm_advancedconfigurator/

 Save

The module configuration is exactly the same as the ThemeConfigurator module.
We just added the ability to choose the order process breadcrumb you want to use.
Indeed, the default order steps breadcrumb uses an image to represent the arrows.
It is not possible to change it without editing the image.

So you can replace it with a new Breadcrumb included in the module that gives you the opportunity to change all you want.

The default file is in the folder :

themes/yourtheme/order-steps.tpl

If you want to use the new breadcrumb added in the module, it will be renamed :

themes/yourtheme/vmadvc-default-order-steps.tpl

If you want to use the default breadcrumb back, it will regain its original name.

- Utilisation -

To view the Advanced Themes Configurator you must be registered as Administrator.
You should see your store (Front Office) coming from your administration interface (Back Office) by clicking on the link **My Shop** in top right of your Back Office.
So your customers do not see the configurator.

The module does not change any tpl or defaults theme css files.

Two files can be created.

A work file and the result is only visible by Admin users coming from Back Office.

This one is named :

modules/vm_advancedconfigurator/css/workmythemeX.css

Where X is the ID of your store.

And a Publish file. The result is visible by your customers on your store (Front Office)

This one is named :

modules/vm_advancedconfigurator/css/mythemeX.css

So, the configurator is multi-store compatible.

You can create as many different themes you have shops.

When you make changes with the theme configurator, you immediately see the changes but they are not really updated. Your visitors can not see them as you have not clicked the **SAVE** button.

To reset the current changes, you must click on the **RESET** button.

Warning: This resets the current changes but not those already saved with the **SAVE** button.

To save your current work, click on **SAVE** button. That will update the work file workmythemeX.css but your customers do not see the result.

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To Publish your work, clic on **PUBLISH** button. That will crete the file mythèmeX.css and the result will be visible by you customer on your store 5FRONT OFFICE). So it is necessary to only clic on that button when you are sur your work is finished.

To remove all changes even already saved, you must click on the **DELETE** button. This will remove the workmythèmeX.css file and all data about your work saved in database.

In this case, you return to your initial theme and you can start a new one.

However, the theme that you publish in the front office is still valid so the file mythèmeX.css are not deleted.

To remove it, you have to go on your server and delete the file

modules/vm_advancedconfigurator/css/mythemeX.css
